


# A BRIEF SYSTEMATIC THEOLOGY ON SATAN



- Created things are everything not God.
- Created things have a definite beginning. They are finite in time & space. They are limited in knowledge & power. They are mutable.
- Angels in Scripture are spiritual beings tasked as messengers, warriors, and guardians of God's glory.
- There are types of angels such as cherubim, seraphim, and archangels.
- Demons in Scripture are fallen angels who oppose God, posses people, and twist God's Word.

• Satan is the leader of the demons who tempted them to fall.

# A couple of ideas for topical Bible studies:

- The Law of First Mention The first time a word is mentioned plants the seed for how it is used throughout the rest of Scripture
  - Gen. I 5:6 "Faith" by believing God and it being accounted as righteousness
  - Issue #I Job written before Genesis
  - Issue #2 Using the English version of the Bible forgetting the original language
- The Clear to Obscure Method (Scripture interpreting Scripture) Start with the easiest to interpret passages and move to the more difficult since Scripture is inerrant.

# MISCONCEPTION #I - TEMPTATION VS TESTING

- Satan tempts us to produce sin and death
  - Jesus teaches us to watch & pray to prevent temptation (Matt. 6:13, 26:41)
  - Some sin is caused by ourselves, the world, or the flesh! (Eph. 2:1-3)

- God tests us to produce faith and righteousness
  - God does not tempt us (James 1:13-14)
  - Think of God's test with Abraham and Isaac on Mt. Moriah

• Hanlon's Razor "Never attribute to malice that which can be adequately explained by incompetence."

#### **EVANGELISM TIP**

Know the Gospels well in order to pivot from difficult questions back to Jesus. 2 Timothy 3:7

- "There is no literal devil" Jesus believes in the Devil and talks with him.
- "The Bible is unreliable" Jesus says that though heaven and earth will pass away, every Word of God will be fulfilled.
- "Jonah could not have been swallowed by a fish" Jesus believes Jonah was in the fish for 3 days and uses it as an illustration for the resurrection.
- "Why does God allow bad things to happen to good people?" Jesus addresses this in John 9 regarding a blind man
